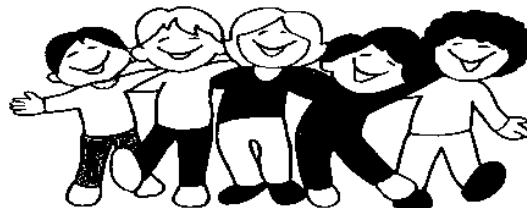

Faith Formation Policies and Regulations

- ❖ Kindergarten through eighth grade sessions are held from 6:30 until 7:45 pm on Wednesday evenings. **Supervision begins at 6:15 pm.**
- ❖ Students will go to their sessions as soon as they arrive.
- ❖ ***To avoid having children crossing the street during heavy traffic times, please consider Livingston Street one-way (East to West). Approach the school building so you drop off and pick up your child on the north side of the street.***
- ❖ ***Due to safety concerns on Wednesday evenings, the North door and the Gym entry door will be locked at 6:30pm. All entries must come through the main South door.***
- ❖ If your child will be absent from class, please let us know. Call **594-2284** or email **rel_ed_stmary@yahoo.com**. If your child is late, please come into the office with him/her to check in.
- ❖ Parents are the primary teachers of faith. You are invited to visit sessions at any time. Please remind your child about courtesy and respect for teachers, for others, and for property.
- ❖ Due to insurance regulations, we require written permission from a parent before we dismiss a child early. Deliver the note to the office before the session begins.
- ❖ Please have your child properly dressed when coming to Faith Formation sessions. When we meet in church, please discourage your child from wearing shorts.
- ❖ The restrooms are primarily for emergency use. Please have your child ready to last an hour and a half stretch without using the restroom facilities.
- ❖ ***When church services are scheduled on Wednesday evenings we ask the parents to attend Mass together with your children. This is a great way to show family support and be a model of faith to your children.***
